We are also celebrating our fantastic set of results, our phonics screening results were 96% and our KS2 results were a significant increase on previous years and well above national. Our combined score which includes reading, writing and maths was 84% compared to the National figure of 61%. This is a 50% increase on our combined in 2022 which was 34%. Our separate reading, writing and maths' scores were all well above the National. A huge well done to the children who have worked really hard this year and to the Year 6 team who have supported, whilst ensuring the children still had a broad and balanced curriculum.

Those of you who have been in school may have seen our all the art that we have framed around the school. Staff and children have been inspired by the breadth and quality of the art. We are proud to celebrate all our children's amazing achievements and talents.

Next week, we have the Y6 production, a pantomime entitled—Cinderella, Rockafella. The children have impressed us all and we know that those of you attending will be blown away.
